

Colorado Antitrust Act of 1992

CRS 6-4-106. Bid-rigging

The Colorado Antitrust Act prohibits bid rigging under § 6-4-106. It is illegal for any person to contract, combine, or conspire with any person to rig any bid, or any aspect of the bidding process, in any way related to the provision of any commodity or service.

The Colorado Court of Appeals in Amos v. Aspen Alps 123, LLC, held that bid rigging is per se illegal under Colorado law.
